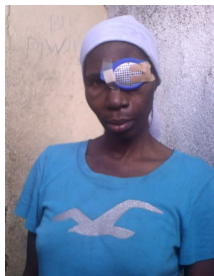

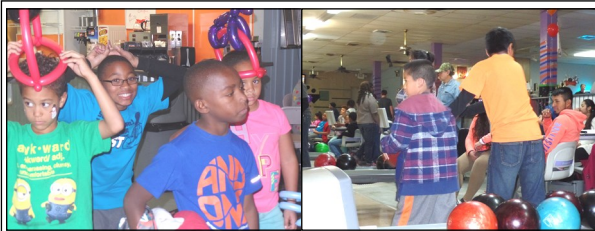


FIRST ANNUAL HOPE TO 5K CHALLENGE 2015
