THE GLORY CLOUD OF THE LORD

WHEN THE CLOUD WAS TAKEN UP THEY SET OUT PREPARING TO BRING DAVIDSON TO THE UNITED STATES:

See Exodus 40:36

In the Book of Exodus the children of the Lord were journeying toward the promised land. The glory and presence of the Lord was visible to them as a cloud. **36...** "Throughout all their journeys whenever the cloud was taken up from over the tabernacle, the sons of Israel would set out; **37** but if the cloud was not taken up, then they did not set out until the day when it was taken up."

OUR CLOUD AS WE WAIT TO BRING DAVIDSON TO THE UNITED STATES: We are trusting God for His perfect timing to bring all the pieces and people together.

Davidson is living with a rare condition, complex bladder exstrophy & epispadias, which was caused by failure of the bladder to close initially. Its incidence is estimated at 1/30,000-50,000 live births according to *African Journal of Paediatric Surgery*. The treatment to correct exstrophy is customarily performed immediately after birth in the United States and in other developed nations. Espispadias repair is done by age 4 or 5. Davidson will turn 10 years old on May 30 and measures 3.2 feet from head to foot.

When the condition Davidson has is left untreated there is urinary incontinence and recurring urinary tract infections which may lead to kidney failure. Malignant change in exposed mucosa is possible.
