#### PRAYING AND PREPARING TO ENTER SEMINARY:



Pastor Jean Thony expects to attend STEP: The Evangelical Theological Seminary of Port-au-Prince during its eight-week summer term. The mission of STEP is to prepare Haitian leaders to make disciples of Christ who will transform their communities for the glory of God.

According to the **BTCP, Bible Training Center for Pastors**, 85% of pastors are not trained. It would be miraculous and a life-changing gift for this pastor in the most remote area of Haiti to be seminary trained. **Please pray** that Pastor Jean Thony's desire to earn a seminary degree will be fulfilled.

**LAND PURCHASE IS ON THE AGENDA:** Our shoe collection ministry and designated donations are the funds that will be used to purchase land and to build our pastor and his family a home.

They were initially homeless, however, someone has let them live in a poorly constructed house that is on land they are willing to sell. It will be enough land to build a house for them and, at some point in the future, to build a guest house that can be used by short term and long-term missionaries, visiting pastors, and other guests.
