WALKING AND RUNNING FOR KIDS IN HAITI:

The night before the event was filled with probably the most intense thunder storm of the season. Thunder rumbled the morning of the event and a 60% prediction of rain threatened to dash plans for the 5K. Nevertheless, God was merciful and the Walk-Run for Haiti on June 1st was successful. FINALLY—PURE WATER IN MARE BLANCHE, HAITI:



The two 500-gallon water tanks with a purification system have finally been installed in Mare Blanche, Haiti. Lives of children and adults in this community will be greatly improved because of it. The 600 member church and make shift school serving 300 students had no water or food. The water purification system is an important step toward helping the people of Mare Blanche meet requirements to qualify for school food from Mission of Hope and other food sources in Haiti.

Another qualifier is a Kitchen and storage room. It sounded like a simple task. However, their location is an unbelievable barrier to their receiving help. Some people will recall that last fall's hurricanes damaged their crops and destroyed buildings, animals and the seed they would have used to plant new crops. There is no industry in the area. The people live off the land. Therefore, when the hurricanes were followed by a drought that lasted until March, their survival was greatly threatened.

HAITI MISSION TRIP APPROACHING

Because the roads to Mare Blanche are not safe, when the Presberrys travel to Haiti July 18-26 they will be staying in Port-au-Prince and bringing the teachers to them for a few days of inquiry, planning and leadership training. The teachers will travel by motor cycle since it is the safest mode of travel for the terrain. Hope for Caribbean Kids, Inc. will purchase food and provide supplies for them to carry back to their community. The Presberrys will be accompanied by Amy and Madison Spencer of Jefferson City.

HOST A SHOE COLLECTION DRIVE AT YOUR CHURCH OR SCHOOL

The water purification project was done in cooperation the Shoeman Water Projects of Fenton, Missouri. The purification system was purchased from George “the Shoeman” Hutchings. That organization drills wells in Africa, South America and Haiti. Hope for Caribbean Kids, Inc. is partnering with them by collecting new and used shoes to help fund their work in Haiti.
